

ANZSHM CONFERENCE GRANTS FOR POSTGRADUATE RESEARCH STUDENTS: INFORMATION REGARDING THE ANZSHM BIENNIAL CONFERENCE, BRISBANE, 12–15 July, 2011

The ANZSHM offers grants for bona fide postgraduate research students to assist them to meet the financial costs of attending the biennial conferences run by the Society, up to one per student. Grants will be awarded at the discretion of the Executive after confirmation of the acceptance of the applicant's paper, and on advice from the Grants Coordinator.

Number and Value of the Grants

- A maximum of **ten** grants is offered for each conference. The final number will depend on the applications received and the budget for that year.
- The maximum value of each grant is \$400 for students resident in the country in which the conference is held, and \$600 for students resident in countries overseas from the conference.
- Each grant will cover the successful applicant's cost of the conference registration and *up to two-thirds* of their travel and accommodation costs to the conference.
- Applications will be considered on an individual basis as they are received.

Eligibility

- Students must be enrolled in a postgraduate research degree in a relevant subject at a university at the time of the conference.
- At the time of the conference, students must be members of the ANZSHM.
- Successful applicants must present a paper on their research at the Conference.
- Preference is given to: full-time students; longer-term members of the ANZSHM; applicants who have not been awarded an ANZSHM Conference Grant before; and those who can demonstrate socio-economic disadvantage.
- Papers must be solely authored by the student and based on their own research. This requirement does not affect any subsequent publication from the paper (in, for example, our refereed journal *Health and History*) which may be dual-authored.

Applying for a Grant

- Applications should be submitted **as early as possible** and before **12 June 2011**.
- Enquiries should be directed to the ANZSHM's 2011 Conference Grants Coordinator Dr Judith Godden, whose contact details are given below, **from 1 November 2010**.
- The application form must be fully completed including all relevant evidence of the expected cost of attending the conference, including the 'early bird' registration fee (note closing date of **23 May 2011**) and economy-level travel and accommodation.
- An applicant's research supervisor must confirm the applicant's student status and that the applicant will benefit from presenting at the Conference.
- Payment of the grant, by cheque or bank transfer, will be made after the successful applicant has presented their paper.
- Applicants will be notified when their application has been received, and can expect to hear the result of their applications within 4-8 weeks.
